Written Report:

Hello all,

I received an email informing me that the minutes from May were dated from April, so that will need to be amended . Also, I have a question for the reports chart. There is no legend and I need one please. The categories appear to be Y, N, X, P, A. So what needs to be reflected is whether the rep is in the meeting and whether there was a report submitted or not please. Are those reflected in those categories and if so...how? Also in the minutes...is the part about schedules reflective of what the conversation led to last month? My memory says otherwise...

In the last month I have reached out to Bob J to ask about his service position. He texted me that he is moving out of the state and intends to step down from his position. I asked him multiple times over the last month to please write a brief report and submit it to reflect this change. As of the time of this writing...I see no report submitted. I spoke with Veronica about this and she also informed me that she will not be able to attend this evening, but has sent a report for me to read in her stead.

I also reached out to our Regional Delegate Kia to ask about facilitating a possible July ASC Inventory. She asked me to email her at the RD regional email which I did and as of yet have not gotten a response in return. Therefor we will not be able to hold an area inventory in July with the RD's. Please inform me how you would like me to proceed?

There was a mix-up the week after last months area meeting. It appears that the situation with the checks and people requesting monies from area is getting a bit confusing for folx. So Mark, our treasurer, and I spoke and came up with a plan. We are attempting to get closer to the way it was prior to the pandemic. Therefor, going forward, if you or your group/committee need funds from area you will need to have either the invoice (prior to the need for the money) or the receipt (after an approved expenditure) with your request. The chairperson/representative will then present this request to area with their report, along with a detailed budget. Once the amount is "approved", 2 of the approved trusted servants on the account will get together when they can to sign said checks, prior to the literature distribution day. Those checks can then either be mailed or the chairperson/representative can pick the checks up at the following literature distribution day. There is a slight possibility that other arrangements can be made, but ALL requests for monies MUST go thru the area meeting prior to the treasurer making any other arrangements , and of course it is at the area admin and treasurers discretion as to if they are available outside of the literature distribution days.

Also, any monies not donated to area through the area Venmo account, can be delivered to our treasurer at the following literature distribution day only.
