Hello friends!

The 2023 Conference Agenda Report (CAR) was released at the end of last month. NAWS discontinued mailing paper publications, including the CAR, at the onset of the Pandemic. Interested members can download the document for free from the link on www.na.org/conference.

NAWS will post PowerPoints and videos summarizing the CAR contents as soon as they are able to complete them. Also posted is the CAR survey at www.na.org/survey. All members are encouraged to fill it out before April 1st, 2023. Survey results help the conference prioritize the work ahead.

Our Regional Delegates will be conducting CAR Workshops in early 2023 hosted by various Areas, including Pierce County and Seattle Areas. All workshops will also be in hybrid form with Zoom Mtg availability. A CAR Workshop event flyer was created listing the dates, times, locations, and Zoom Mtg information. The flyer is posted in the Upcoming Events section of our Area website. I plan on getting some printed copies to the Literature Chair to hand out with the Lit orders. I also plan to try to get email addresses or phone numbers of local Homegroup GSR's or members to help spread the flyer around to the groups. Maybe post the flyer on the Recovery Garage FB page or whatever other ideas the body can give me. I am open to any suggestions to help spread the word about these upcoming events.

It is highly encouraged to attend one of the CAR Workshops if you can to get educated on the items on the report that the homegroups will have to vote on. I will need to gather and bring all of the votes from our area homegroups back to the April RSC meeting.

The January RSC meeting is scheduled for January 14th, 2023, at 10:30am. It will be virtual only. All-Sub Committee meetings will also be virtual on different evenings the week before RSC meets. All-Sub meeting times and Zoom information can be found on the WNIRNA.ORG website. All Sub-committee Chairs are expected to attend their respective meetings. So please plan accordingly.

Lastly, as announced back in May, expect a price increase in all books and bronze medallions effective January 1, 2023.
